



Alberta Teachers' Association Fort McMurray Local #48 ATA Memorial Scholarship

The ATA Memorial Scholarship was established in remembrance of all teachers who have contributed to the education of the youth in Fort McMurray schools. These scholarships are awarded annually to graduates of either Fort McMurray Public or Catholic high schools whose parents are current or former members of ATA Local #48. A student can receive only one scholarship in either of the first two years of their post-secondary education.

Value: \$1000 (\$500 each semester)
Number: 2 scholarships
Tenable: Any post-secondary institution
Deadline: **October 1**

Eligibility: Applicant will be weighed on the following criteria:

- Academic achievement (statement of marks)
- Character reference (one letter) provided by student
- Involvement in extracurricular/volunteer activities
- Work experience hours/credits
- Enrolment in a post-secondary institution
- Consideration will be given to how many years the student has attended Fort McMurray schools as well as how many years the parent(s)/guardian have taught within ATA Local 48.

The applicant must send the completed application form and one letter of reference to the President of ATA Local #48. The applicant must request a transcript of marks from the Department of Education and forward them to:
